The General Insurance Association of Japan (GIAJ) has released the figures for claims paid (as of August 31, 2023) for the heavy rainfall due to a "Baiu" front (rainy season front) and Typhoon No. 2 (Mawar), 2023, and the heavy rainfall beginning on July 7, 2023.
